If you are new to officiating and age 17 or older, you can apply for your first IHSA License through this class and pay only \$35 (normally \$70). (Discount not available if you register to be an official on the IHSA website or if you already hold an officials license in any other sport with the IHSA.) *If you are age 15 or 16 you can apply at IHSA.org for a discounted limited provisional license. (Click on the Officals tab.)

Officials already licensed with 1-8 years experience, have also been regular attendees at these classes, and are welcome to participate to advance their skills.
